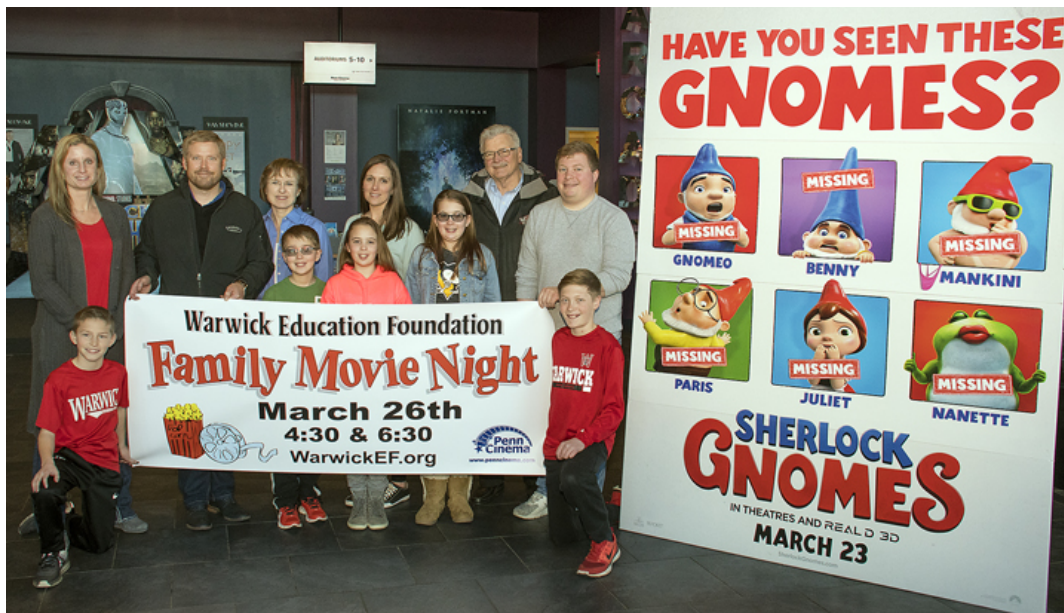


Warwick Education Foundation Family Movie Night
