

# HISTORIC POOLE FORGE

Historic Poole Forge is a 26-acre community park purchased by Caernarvon Township and run by the Historic Poole Forge Board of Directors as a non-profit. Dr. Dawn Rise Ekdahl is the executive director. The property is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and the grounds encompass an Iron Forge plantation featuring a 1770s Ironmaster's mansion, a covered bridge, a lime kiln, multiple stone accessory buildings including a bed and breakfast, a picnic pavilion, a nature walking trail, ball fields and many beautiful gardens throughout the grounds.



They are one of the most beautiful locations in Eastern Lancaster County for wedding and portrait photography. Historic Pool Forge is the perfect place to host a wedding. Wedding packages include multiple outdoor ceremony spaces, spacious bridal suite access for both the bride and groom's attendants to get ready, the ability to set up the day before and clean up the day after the wedding, two kitchen areas for caterers and the mansion patio and porch areas for cocktail hours. Wine and beer service is permitted as per the event contract. The focus for weddings is to provide a quiet, relaxed atmosphere with ample time for the wedding couple to enjoy their day without distractions.

At Poole Forge, they have a strong respect for the environment. They have continually improved the grounds through the planting of riparian buffers, pollinator gardens, grassland meadows, restoration of the creek and ecology programs for children into the summer time. Free Community events are offered throughout the year.
