

LANCASTER AIRPORT (LNS)

The Lancaster Airport is an integral part of the Pennsylvania aviation landscape and strives to provide quality service to Lancaster County. It is the third busiest airport in Pennsylvania and offers commercial air service to Pittsburgh International Airport (PIT), Washington/Dulles International Airport (IAD) and Philadelphia International Airport (PHL). The airport is home to 130 corporate and private aircraft, 20+ businesses and three flight schools. They are also a frequent stop for military aircraft due to their close proximity to Ft. Indiantown Gap, as well as other military bases. On any given day, the airport sees a robust amount of activity.

Lancaster Airport provides valuable services to their customers including commercial air service by Southern Airways Express and American Airlines:

- Southern Airways Express: Southern is a commuter airliner offering service twice a day to PIT and three times a day to IAD. They are interline partners with American Airlines, United Airlines and Alaska Airlines allowing for single-ticketing and baggage transfers between them. This allows



passengers to catch a connecting flight to anywhere within the airlines' network.

- American Airlines recently started a new service using a 35-seat premium motorcoach to take passengers from LNS to PHL, offering the same single-ticketing and baggage transfer, allowing passengers to catch a connecting flight anywhere in their network.

Also on-site is Alliance Aviation, Lancaster Airport's Fixed Based Operator (FBO), providing aviation services to the General Aviation community. Their new modern facility is adjacent to the terminal and includes both a pilot's lounge and a passenger waiting area, along with many other amenities.

Some of the larger businesses that call LNS home include:

- Aero-Tech Services – offering flight training in airplanes, charter services, aircraft management, consulting and maintenance services.

- Fiorentino's Restaurant – Italian eatery that offers outdoor seating with a runway view and a full bar with an ample beer selection.

- FlyAdvanced - their Lancaster location is the largest authorized Cirrus service center worldwide.

- Lancaster Avionics – a nationally known company that has customers fly in for avionic sales and repairs.

- Sport Flying USA
Services Bristell Aircraft

– provides flight training, aircraft maintenance and aircraft sales. They are the assembly location for all United States Bristell Aircraft.

- Venture Jets – offers a wide array of services ranging from executive air charter, air ambulance transportation and aircraft management.

Based on a recent report, LNS contributes \$52 million to the local economy. Air transportation is essential for business attraction and retention, plays a key role in economic development and is the gateway to the nation's air transportation system and the world's economy.
