The Artisan Mill building is a restored grain mill building that sits next to the railroad tracks. The Artisan Mill currently showcases eight artisans and their creations. adjacent to the parking lot and has stands that offer antiques, collectibles, clothing, jewelry, toys, comics and other unique flea market finds.

The original mill building was built in the early 1900s, and the flea market started in 1983. Root's Country Market and Auction, Inc. purchased the flea market property in 2005 as an extension of their Tuesday tradition that started in 1925.

Root's Old Mill Flea Market is open Tuesdays year-round, but recently the owners added a seasonal Saturday Flea Market to the calendar. Saturday Flea Market opens for its season on the first Saturday in April. The Saturday Flea Market season ends with a special flea market day on the Saturday before Thanksgiving. This addition to the calendar offers a different atmosphere than Tuesdays and customers appreciate being able to shop Root's Old Mill Flea Market during the weekend. The hours for Saturdays are 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
